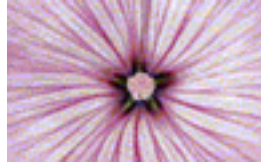

- In 1990 I began my studies in the Sufi Tradition. By 1995 I took “Hand” (joined the Jerrahi order), and received the spiritual name of “Rabia” from Lex Hixon Nur Al Jerrahi.
- In 1993 I received the Ascension Attunement with Maha Kulki Avatara. Maha Kulki had received a message from Guru Gobind (Archangel Michael), while in the state of nirvana, to bring the Ascension to the United States. I trained under Maha Kulki for a year, doing Ascensions under her guidance. When Maha Kulki went back to India she said that I should continue the work in the United States. For the next year I continued in Colorado, New Mexico and California. To this day I still do Ascension Attunements.
- I joined Siddha Yoga in 1995. While at the Ashram, I had a mystical experience with Guru Baba Muktananda which made a profound difference in my life. This experience guided me to frequently visit the Ashram and to attend the intensives and programs. In addition, I studied their correspondence courses over the next ten years. To this day I still practice Meditation and Chanting in the Siddha Yoga Tradition.
- In 2000 I was ordained as a Priest in the Order of Melchizedek by Rev. Dan Chesbro. I am licensed to perform weddings and other blessings.
